The new and patented TRIPLEX pallet enclosure, with its integrated strap, means you can transform a conventional container system into a sustainable and reusable bulk goods container within a matter of seconds. With QuickBulk, bulk goods can be transported and stored cost-effectively and in an exceptionally space-saving format. This makes it the perfect alternative to big bags, box pallets and cardboard containers.

QuickBulk – using a strap to keep bulk goods in shape

Anybody who works with bulk goods is all too familiar with the problem of containers which don't keep their shape. One issue is that when containers bulge out, they stop working perfectly within production facilities in day-to-day operations. What's more, misshapen containers cause problems when it comes to transport and storage, as it is often difficult or even impossible to put lids on them. This means they can no longer be stacked for space-saving storage.

QuickBulk, with its smart strap system combined with the TRIPLEX pallet enclosure, offers the perfect solution for the space-saving storage and secure transport of bulk goods. The exceptionally tear-resistant polyester strap, featuring special stitching, wraps around the top third of the container. It is threaded through a total of eight precisely sized slits and runs along the inside and outside of the container alternately. The strap strengthens the side walls of the container, so there is much less bulging.

Bulk goods containers fitted with QuickBulk are the ideal solution when it comes to filling, transporting, storing and emptying products such as pre-forms, fasteners and other small bulk goods.

QuickBulk is flexible as it can be adapted to just about any pallet system. It is important that the pallet enclosure and the pallet are securely joined together. To ensure this, QuickBulk can have cut-outs punched into it to accommodate customised pallet locking systems. What's more, there is the option of integrating the "comfort" folding TRIPLEX container bases into the sleeve. The pallet enclosure is then fixed onto the pallet automatically as a result of the weight of the bulk goods pressing down on the container base.

The foldable TRIPLEX comfort base is securely welded to the sleeve and held against the inside of the sleeve's side wall by a hook-and-loop fastener. Once the sleeve has been placed on the pallet, the base can be folded down effortlessly so that it lies entirely on the pallet. The flat surface also prevents small bulk goods from getting left behind in indentations or the pallet feet when the container is emptied.

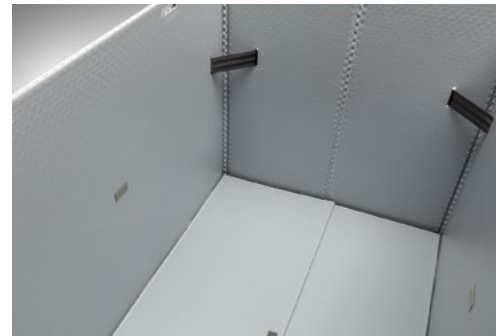

Configuration options – the extra dimension in functionality

In its basic configuration, QuickBulk is made of TRIPLEX 10 structured-core panels with a weight of 3,000 g/m² and with a silvery-grey colour similar to RAL 7001. It comes with a polyester strap that is 48 mm wide and 1.2 mm thick. QuickBulk can be produced with either open or closed edges, as preferred, and features an M fold so it can be collapsed for space-saving storage. A variety of configuration options is available, many of which can be combined – making QuickBulk customisable:

- Sleeve panels in optimum weights for the required loads
- Various sleeve heights available
- Pallet-specific foot contours
- Punched cut-outs for base and lid locking mechanisms
- Customer-specific colours, including bicolour options
- Motifs can be printed on one to four sides, including in multiple colours
- Printing layout is coordinated with the position of the strap
- Closed edges in two variants:
 - "Standard edge", whereby the edges are pressed flatly together
 - "Rounded edge" for a finish that is even more comfortable to handle
- Document pouches and label holders
- RFID or barcode labels
- TRIPLEX "comfort" container base
